In 2016, after forming a really strong connection over the years, we finally became an item. We knew from the day we started dating that we would spend our lives together.










We tied the knot on June 15th, 2019! We loved celebrating this occasion with our closest friends and family (second time's a charm!).










We both love games, and have a few traditions / routines related to games:
